Points are bad in this game 1st team to get 5 points has to do 10 jumping jacks correctly. Points are given by the teacher. Points are given when:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students cross either the orange or maroon line Students catch or kick the ball Students punch or head butt the ball The ball lands in the square <p>When a ball lands out of bounce the last person who touched the ball the point will go to their team</p> <p>Finally when serving if they serve down</p> <p>After the scoring rules are given have students review the rules with their team (turn and tell).</p> <p>Teacher serves the 1st round of each new game. After a team has to do jumping jack the teams will rotate counter clockwise and a new server will be in the middle.</p>
